UPDATE

Mathew 13:23 "But he who received seed on the good ground is he who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and produces; some a hundred fold, some sixty, some thirty". The seed you have planted in Africa, dear Faith Listeners, has fallen on good ground and has multiplied. The number of people you have reached with the gospel is amazing. Thank you for your love for Christ, which is demonstrated by your giving to reach many people in Africa with the love of our risen Lord. You have remained true to Jesus call "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations..." Mathew 28:19.

Over the past one month, the number of listeners has increased remarkably, we are getting numerous phone calls of encouragement; those whose lives have been touched and have accepted Christ as Lord and savior, miracle healings and God's providence in peoples lives.

The statistics we are getting indicate that the most populous parts of Kenya; Western, North & South Rift, parts of Nyanza and Uganda border towns receive our broadcasts loud and clear. The number of people that are potentially covered by our broadcasts is about 7.2 million with at least 100,000 people tuned in to our broadcasts at any given time. The initial targeted area of Mt. Elgon is partially receiving our broadcasts though not all areas. The reason why Mt. Elgon was in our hearts is because until recently, it was among the un-reached people group with the gospel of our risen Lord. We are still trusting the Lord to enable us cover the whole mountain.

We have applied for frequencies for Webuye/Kisumu and Eldoret/Timboroa for our next tower site which we have not received any feedback from the ministry of Communications as yet, but I am making follow-ups with them to see a possibility of getting them allocated to us.

STAFF DEVELOPMENT

We are currently geared to provide in-house workshops for the staff to better develop their skills so as to serve in the ministry more effectively. They are also enrolled in various courses at our seminary school.

We have initiated a cooperative scheme where the staff contribute to it and are eligible to take loans during emergencies and pressing fees needs after six months of saving. The cooperative awarded its first loan applicant this week. The occasion was witnessed by among others, Rev. Kibii arap Maiyo, the ICM Administrative Secretary, Rev. Chege, ICM Deputy Principal (Academics) and the staff.
